

# To do

To do – in the present tense	
I	do
you	do
he, she, it	does*
we	do
you	do
they	do

**Remember**  
that there is an  
-s on the verb  
in 3rd person  
present tense!

To do – in the past tense	
I	did
you	did
he, she, it	did
we	did
you	did
they	did

**Note that the  
verb in past  
tense has only  
one form!**

I	have done
you	have done
he, she, it	has done*
we	have done
you	have done
they	have done

**Remember**  
that there is an  
–s on the  
auxiliary verb  
in 3rd person  
present  
perfect!

To do – in the pluperfect	
I	had done
you	had done
he, she, it	had done
we	had done
you	had done
they	had done

**Note that in  
the pluperfect  
there is only  
one form!**
